STROKE PLAY Rules & Guidance

 Format is Individual STROKE PLAY. TOTAL NET SCORE on your Slope adjusted Handicap for the day determines your result.

Note; For the event 27 September at PGS there will be a separate winner from each division based on Stableford scoring.

2. **Scorecards** – please keep and write your own card – cards that are illegible, not signed and attested MAY be disqualified;

Enter ONLY the number of shots taken on each hole

One card to be submitted per player to Club staff (if you wish to record putts or other information, please use a separate card for your own purposes.

Enter your stableford points if you know how to calculate

Sign the card AND ask a playing partner to sign to attest your score

- 3. **Submit the card** at reception area to club staff a box will be provided.
- 4. Tee boxes your scorecard will show you which tee to play from, Blue, White or Red
- 5. **Divisions A, B or C -** are based on your latest Handicap Index and determined by BSGS Handicap Committee. The parameters may change at every event depending on the number of entrants and your Handicap Index
- 6. **Circles on green** if your ball stops on or inside the circle line, pick up and add one shot to your score
- 7. **Lift and clean** (Preferred lies) check with committee members or club staff if this relief applies on the day It is dependent on the weather conditions. Relief may be given either on the fairway or through the green or, in severe wet conditions, relief may be given through the course (e.g. In the rough).
- 8. **Plugged ball** you may lift and clean without penalty even if your ball is in the rough. **Lost ball plugged** if you and your playing partners agree your ball plugged and is lost anywhere except out of bounds or in a hazard, you may drop a new ball without penalty.
- 9. **If you unsure of any ruling** confer with partners, if still unsure, play a second ball as well as the first and note both scores before consulting a committee member after you finish to decide which score applies.

The BSGS Committee retain the right to decide on rulings, handicaps and scores submitted.
